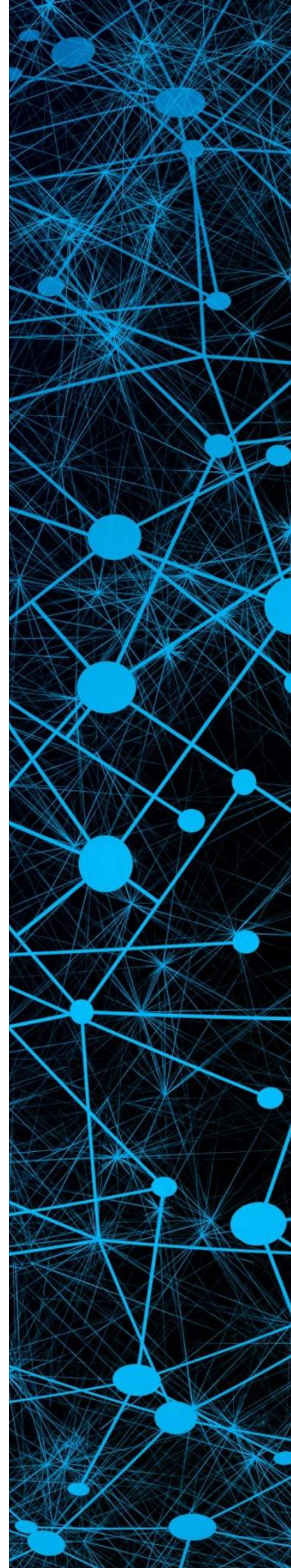
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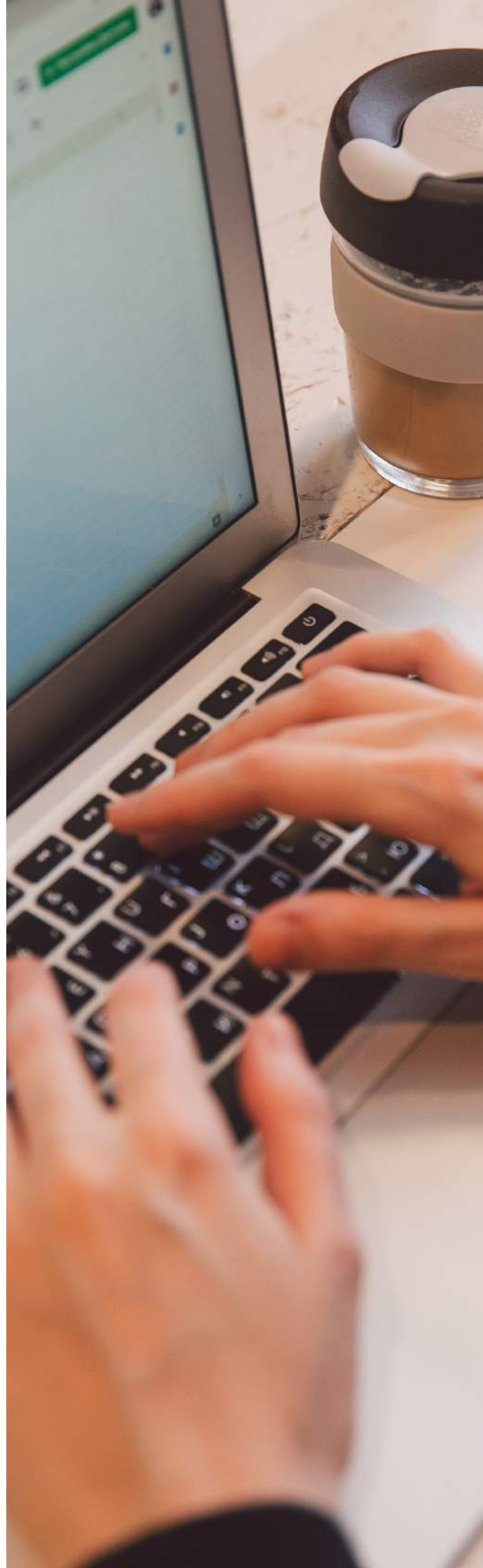

What is Canva?



Canva is a graphic designing tool that is very easy to use & helps in creating amazing designs quickly.

The beauty of this tool is it does not require any installations on your PC. You can access it at www.canva.com

Alternatively, you can also use the Canva mobile app. But, I would recommend you to use it on PC for designing easily & quickly.

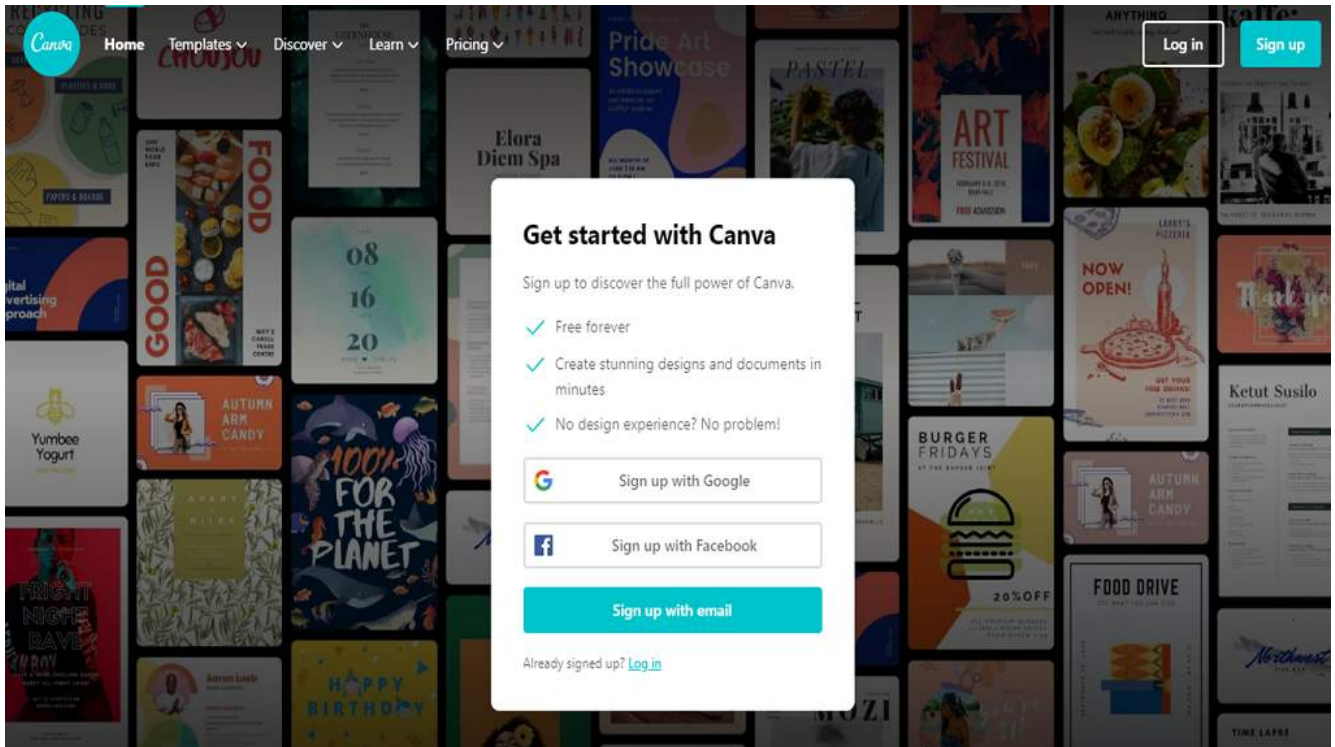
Once you are used to it, you can gradually use your Canva mobile app for some quick designs too.



The tool is FREE. Although, there is a paid version - Canva Pro. Canva Pro, obviously has more features than the FREE Canva. But, you can design amazing graphics even using the free version of this tool.



How to use Canva?



Firstly, we log in to www.canva.com and create your account or sign up with Google or Facebook.

When you will Sign Up & Login for the first time, you will be asked "What will you be using Canva for?"

Select the right option so that Canva can recommend you the designs and templates as per your profile.

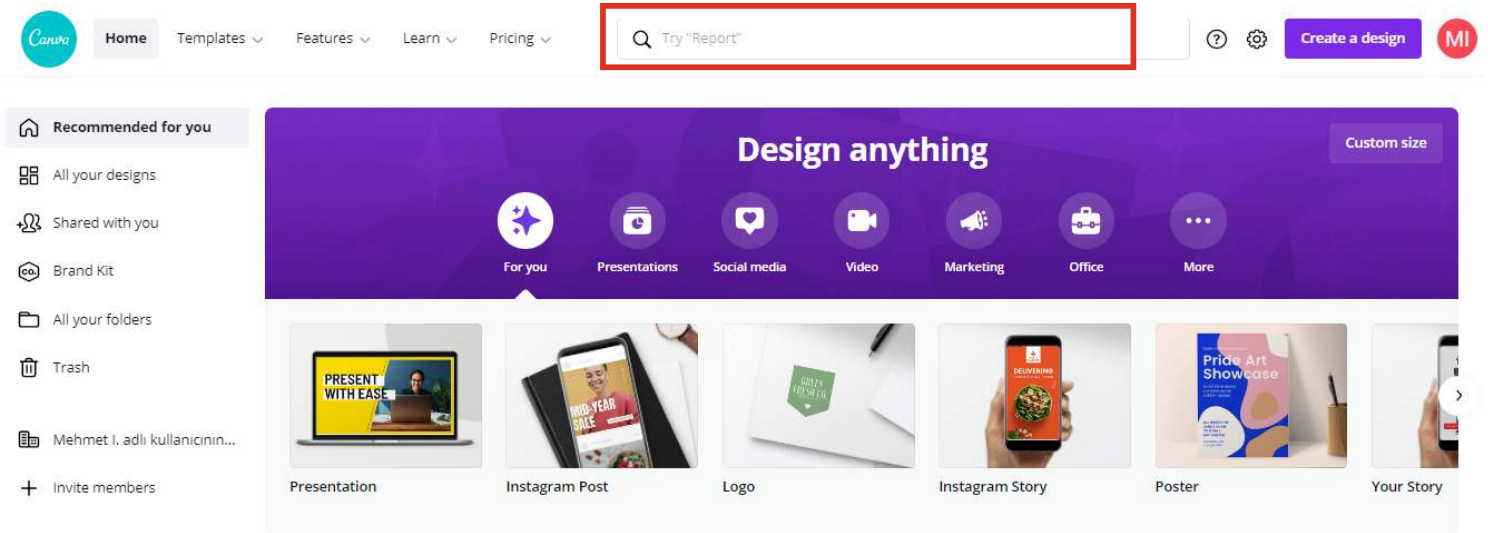
The various options available are,

1. Teacher
2. Student
3. Personal
4. Small Business
5. Large Company
6. Non-profit or Charity

Select whatever you are and proceed.

In the search bar, start typing the name of the platform for which you want to create the graphic. Or, select the templates from below.

There are various options like presentations, social media, video, marketing, office etc.

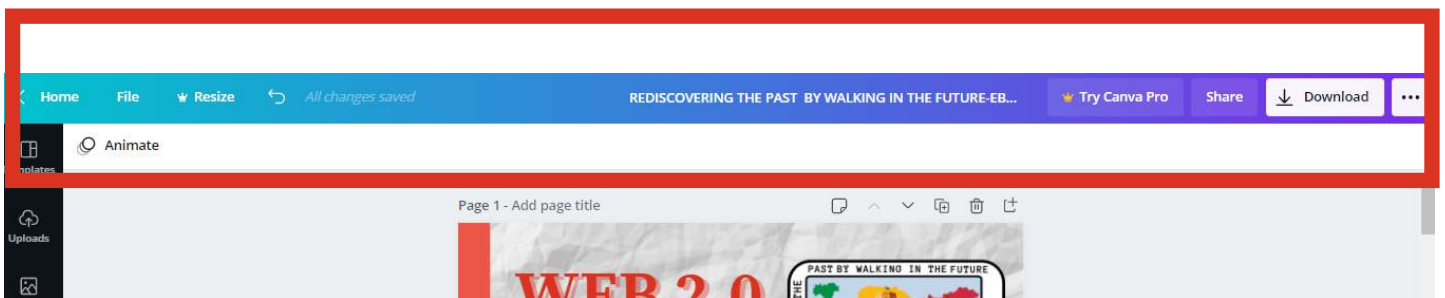


If you want to create a graphic with a custom size, in the right-hand corner you can find the "Custom Size" option. Click on it and proceed.

When you start designing, you can add the text, image or any other element from the left-hand toolbar. All you need to do is drag-and-drop.

Canva - Menubar

Like in any other tool, Canva's menu bar is at the top of the editor.



As you can see, the menubar is made up of the following features

1. Home
2. File
3. Resize
4. Saving Status
5. Design name
6. Try Canva Pro
7. Share
8. Download

Home

When you click on Home, you will be taken to the home page of the tool.

File

The File feature will open a drop-down with the list of features like Create new design, Show rulers, Show margins, Save, Download, etc. You can also see the dimensions of the canvas here. The design name can be edited too.

Resize

The Resize option is not available with Free Canva. The purpose of this feature is to allow one to resize the dimensions after having created a design.

Saving Status

In the menubar, next to the Resize feature, you can see the saving status. It is usually "All changes saved". In case of any error, while saving, you will get a message here.

Design Name

By default Canva names the design as "Untitled Design". You can edit the name by clicking on it or through the File feature too.

Try Canva Pro

This is an advertisement by Canva to make you try Canva Pro for Free for the first 30 days.

Share

You can share your designs with other team members. Multiple members can work on a single design. Type the name or email of the person with whom you wish to share the design. Sharing has 3 options,

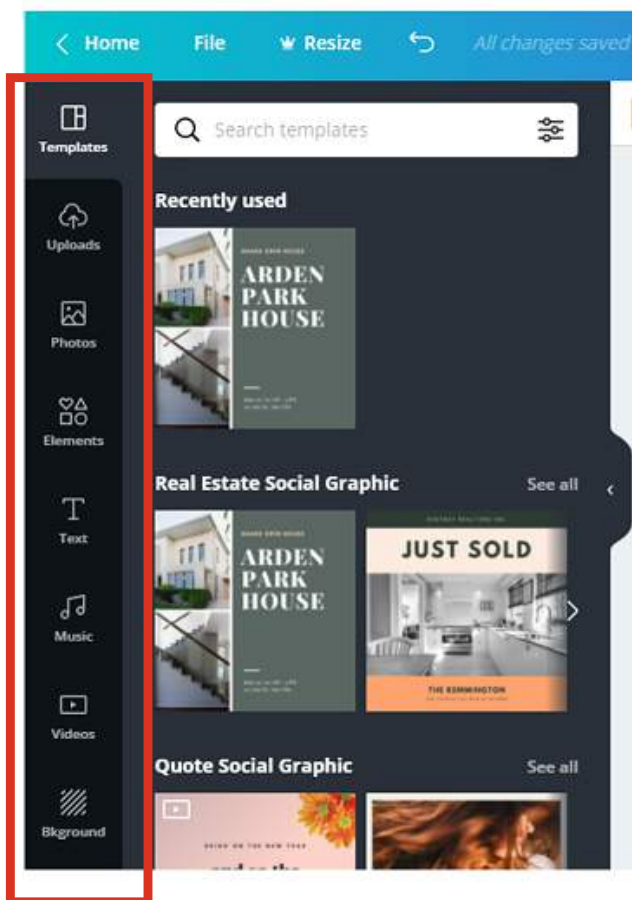
- Share a link to edit
- Share a link to use as a template (Available only with Canva Pro)
- Share a link to view

Just select the option of your choice and copy the link & give it to the person.

Download

This lets you download the design. There are various file types available. Also if you click to the dropdown arrow next to the download button, you can directly share the design to your social media, Google Drive, MailChimp, etc.

TABS IN THE SIDE PANEL OF CANVA



Templates

This tab consists of the pre-built templates that can be used to design a graphic. There are a lot of templates under this tab. All you need to do is click on the template of your choice and it will get loaded in the canvas. Then you can edit the text, colors and other elements of the template as per your preference.

Elements

A design is made up of various elements like text, icons, photos, etc. The elements tab in the Canva side panel consists of a lot of elements like shapes, icons, frames, etc that can be used in the design. Also, you can search for an element of your choice.

Uploads

The uploads tab in the Canva Side Panel allows you to upload your photos and videos. You can upload your images and use them in your design using this tab. Simply click on upload, select the photo, upload it and then from this tab, click on it to use it in the design.

Photos

The Photos tab allows you to use the existing photos that Canva provides. Not all photos are available for free. But there is a good amount of free photos in this tab that you can use in your design. Alternatively, you can upload your own photo using the Uploads tab.

Text

The text tab gives you access to a lot of text in various styles and colors that you can use in your design. You can either select the simple text and then change its font style using the toolbar or you can use the predefined styles that you get here.

Music

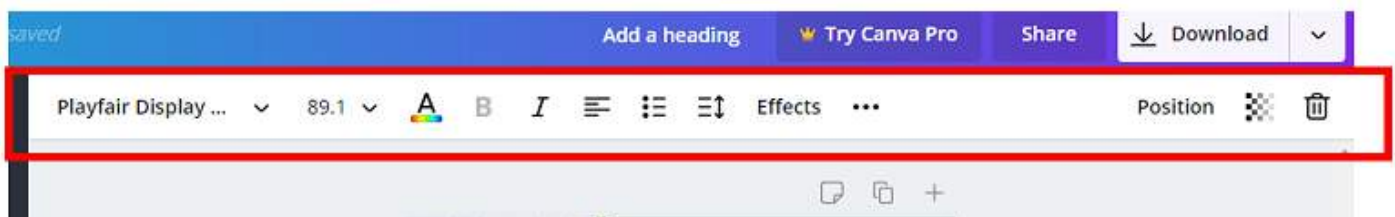
Canva also allows you to edit videos and you can use this music tab to add the music that is available in Canva's repository.

Videos

Just like photos and music, you can get beautiful videos in this tab to create a custom video of your own. Alternatively, you can use the Uploads tab to upload your own video and edit it.

Background

As the name implies, the background tab allows you to select a background for your graphic. The background can be a solid color or graphic that is available in this tab. This tab has a lot of templates that you can use in the background of your graphic. There are a lot of textures and images available. You can also edit the color and give effects to the background texture that you select using the toolbar.



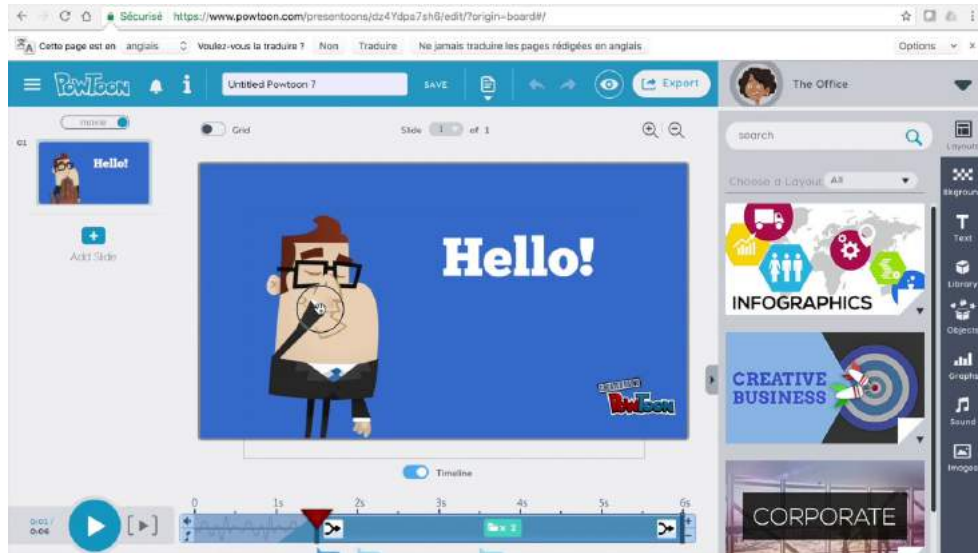
As you can see in the screenshot above, I selected the text in the template and the toolbar displays options to change the font, font size, color, alignment, etc.

- Reinforce accountability – know if students are watching the video, how many times and whether they understand.

How Do I Create A Video Lesson?

Start by clicking on **CREATE**.

Select your video from the various channels, enter a video URL or upload one.

Click **USE VIDEO** to open the video editor screen

1. CROP Video
Only use what you need. Use the red sliders to set the start and end places

2. Add AUDIO TRACK
Explain your video with your own voice and teaching approach, and in your own language. You need to record the audio track for the **WHOLE VIDEO** in order to **SAVE** it.

Click on the microphone symbol, enable microphone and start speaking, record track in real time.

Click yellow button to overwrite any previous recordings. Red to cancel.

Reset the whole recording Remove the last recording



Add AUDIO NOTES

Insert an introductory comment, a remark, a note, a conclusion or summary.

Move the yellow slider to the point in the video where you want to insert note and click on the yellow microphone button to start recording, click again to finish.

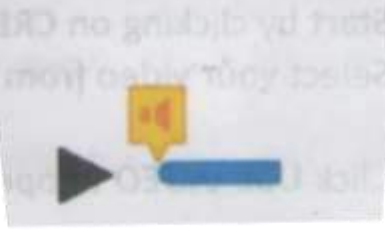


To add another note move slider to next position and repeat process.

To remove last note click the yellow button. To remove all new notes click



To delete a saved note. Click on the small yellow square and then the red recycle bin

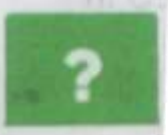
Add QUIZZES

Insert quizzes, assessments or written notes to your video to assess your students' understanding and to ensure the effectiveness of your video

Move the green slider to the point in the video where you want to insert quiz and click on the green button



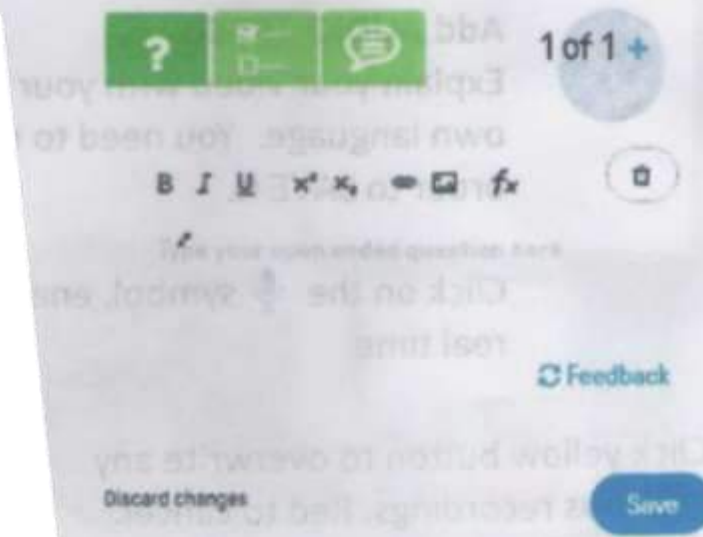
There are three types of quizzes:



Open ended question

Type your question in the box and click SAVE.

You can use the button to add additional questions at the same point

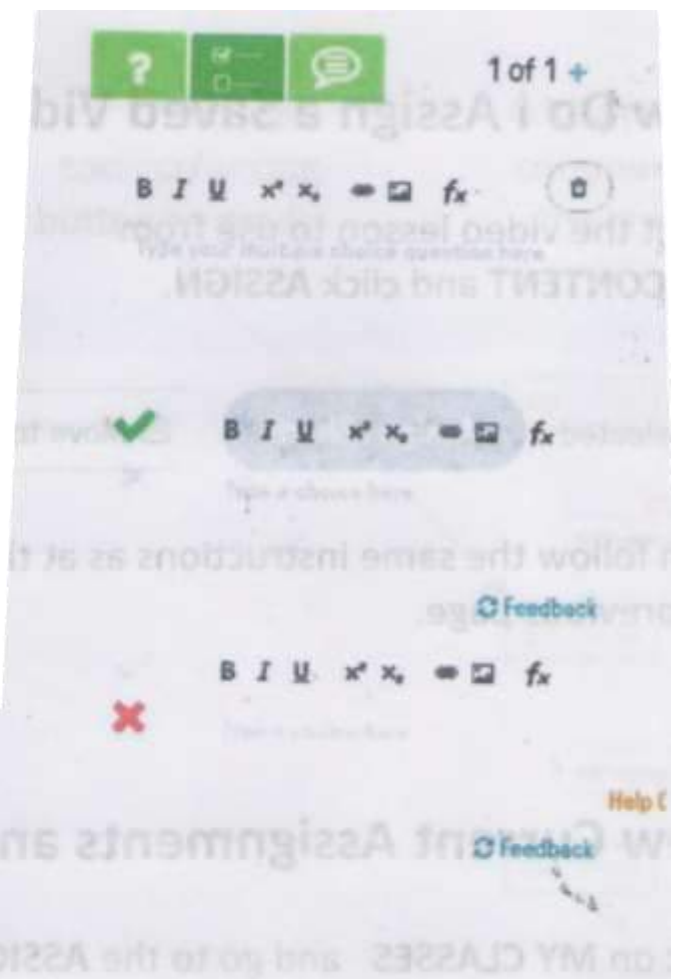


Multiple Choice question

Type your question in the, and your answers in the boxes beneath. There must be at least two answers.

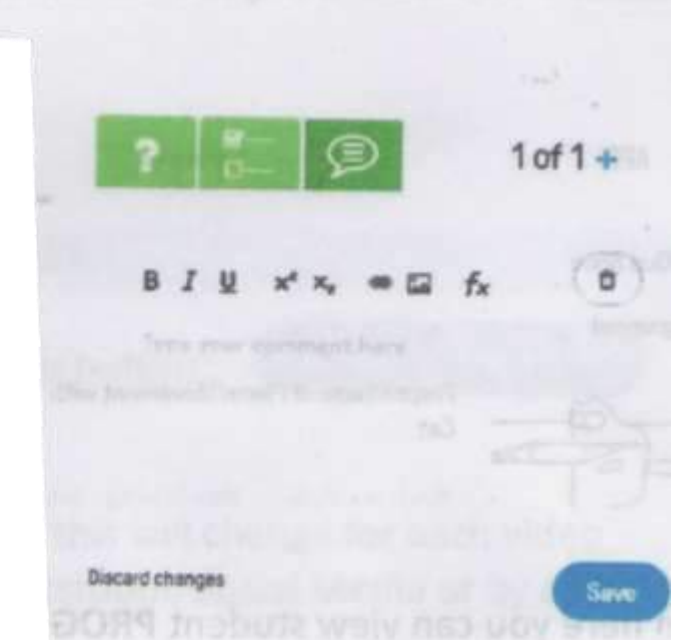
Click on the tick to mark the answer as correct or the cross to mark it incorrect.

You can add extra answers by clicking on the button. Don't forget to SAVE



Comment

Type your comment in the box and SAVE



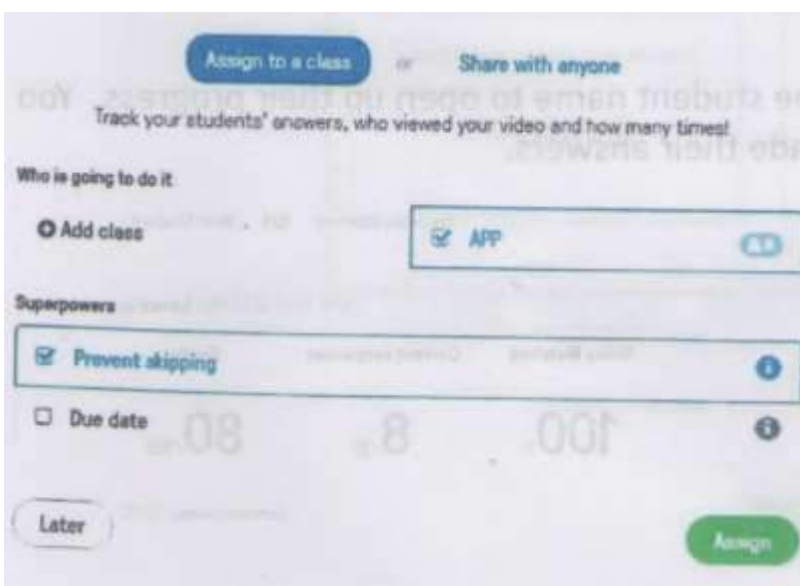
When you've completed your video, click **FINISH**.

Share with anyone – give out the link to colleagues.

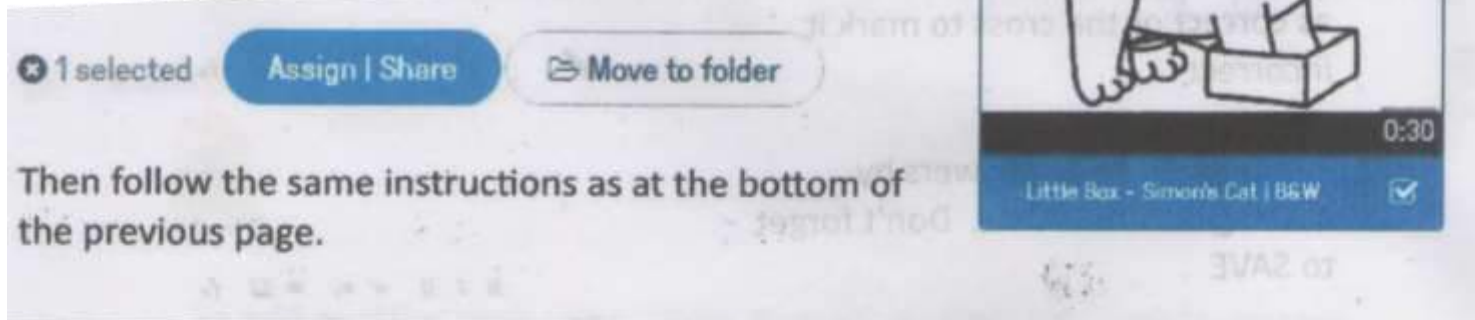
Prevent Skipping – this prevents students from skipping part of the video lesson

How Do I Assign a Saved Video Lesson?

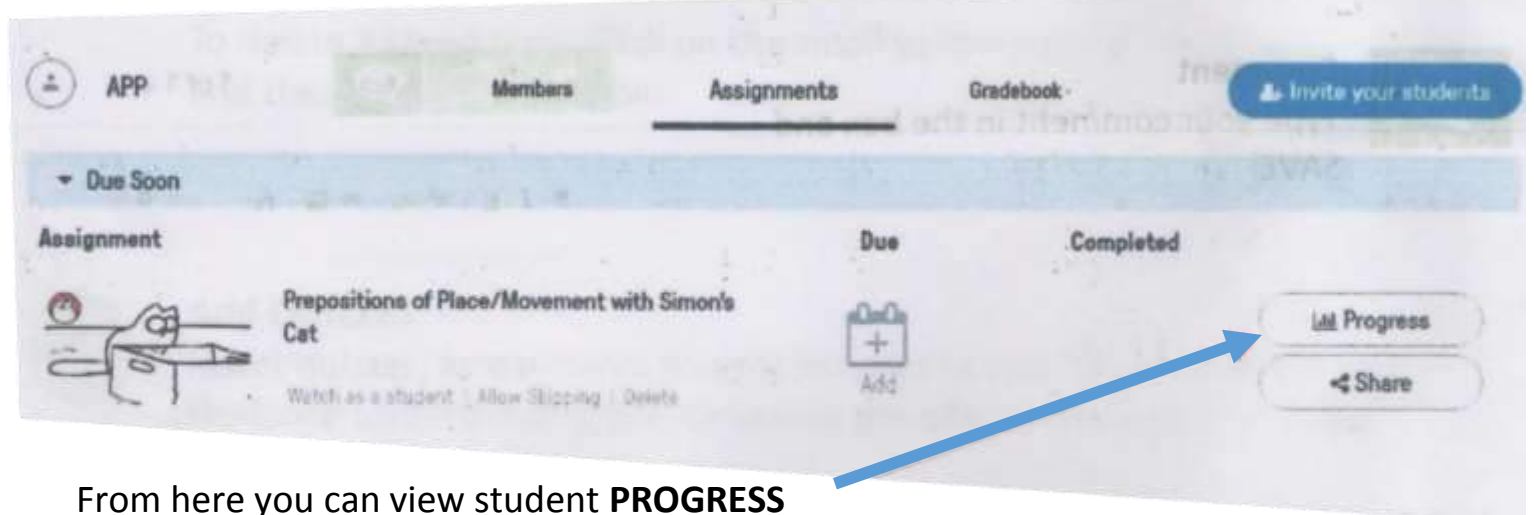
Select the video lesson to use from **MY CONTENT** and click **ASSIGN**

Click the **PROGRESS** button. Then click on the student name to open up their progress. You can view how they viewed the video and grade their answers.





At the top of the screen is the toolbar:



- **Find Kahoots** – find ready-made kahoots on every subject
- **My Kahoots** – these are yours, those you have created, or you have marked as favourites, and those that have been shared with you by other users
- **My results** – download the results of played kahoots
- **FAQ** – frequently asked questions
- **Support** – online help

On the far right is a purple button **NEW K!** - click here to begin creating a brand new kahoot.

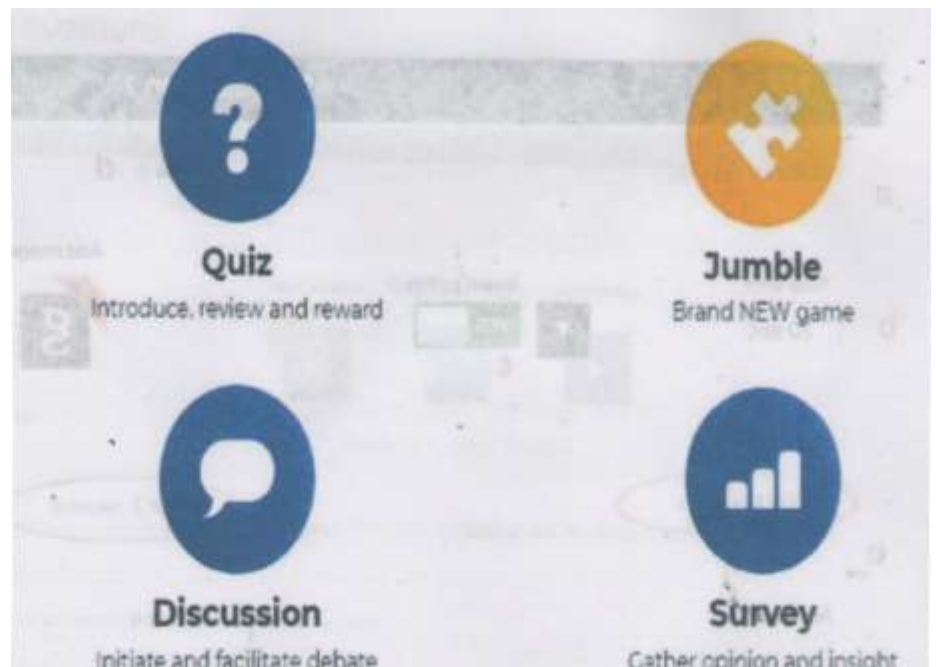
How Do I Create A Kahoot?

Click on the **NEW K!** button

This page contains a stats box, giving you details of how many kahoots you have, how many people have played and whether a kahoot has been shared or marked as favourite.

On the main page are links to the types of activities you can create – Choose which you want:

- **Quiz** – the standard quiz, great for reviewing lessons, introducing subjects
- **Jumble** – a game where students must unjumble a series of cards. Great for maths formulae, sentence structure etc.
- **Discussion** – use to initiate a one-question discussion during a lesson/lecture (you can analyse results at a later stage)
- **Survey** – with no right or wrong answers, survey gathers information during a lesson (you can analyse results at a later stage)



Create A Quiz

1. Choose **QUIZ** and complete the **TITLE** screen

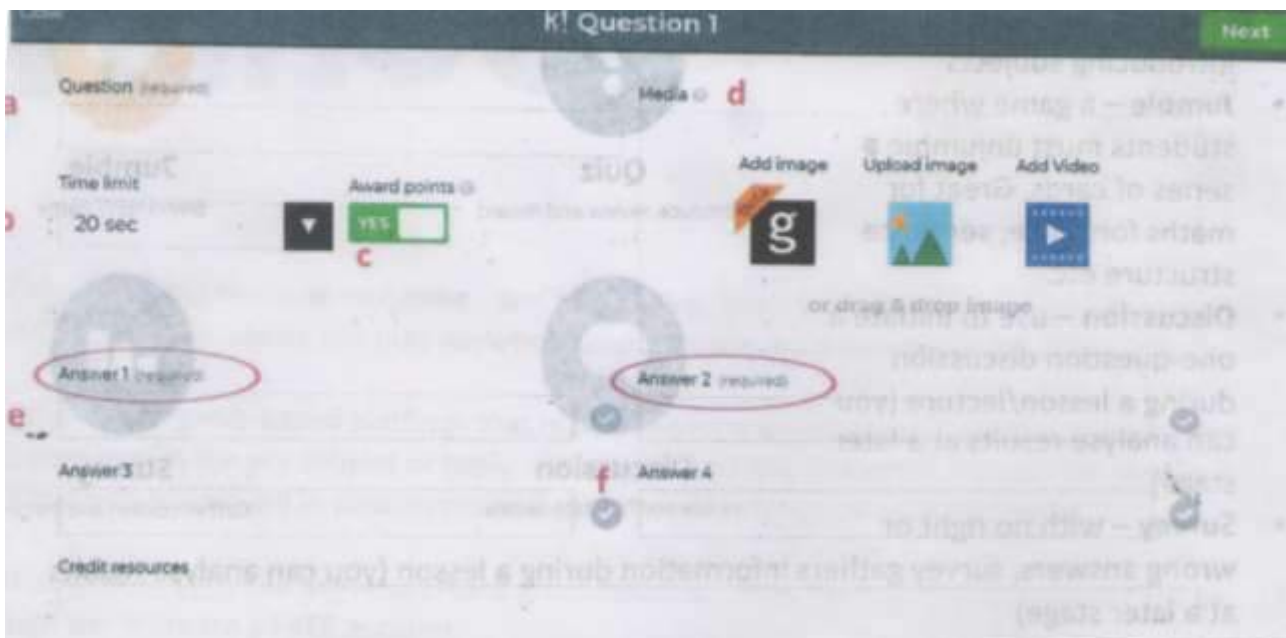

A cover image can be uploaded if you wish, and you have the option to change language and privacy setting. When complete, Click the **OK, Go** button at the top of the page.

2. On the next page – the Game Creator, click **ADD QUESTION**.

Here we start creating questions:



- a) Type in your question. There is a 95 character limit so word it carefully, and the option for formatting tools.
- b) Each question is timed – you can change settings from 5 secs up to 2 mins
- c) Choose whether to switch on/off the points setting. Leaving the points on makes a much more enjoyable and competitive experience for your students.
- d) If you wish, you can add image from your PC, use one of the *Getty images* from Kahoot or upload a video from YouTube.
- e) Enter up to four possible answers – You MUST have at least 2 answers, **Answer 1** and **Answer 2**. Note there is a 60 character limit for answers.
- f) Click on the grey ticks to mark the answer as correct, the ticks will turn green. You can have more than one correct answer.
- g) When complete, click on the green **NEXT** to go on to the next question, and repeat the process from 2a. After the last question, click **SAVE** on the Game Creator Page.

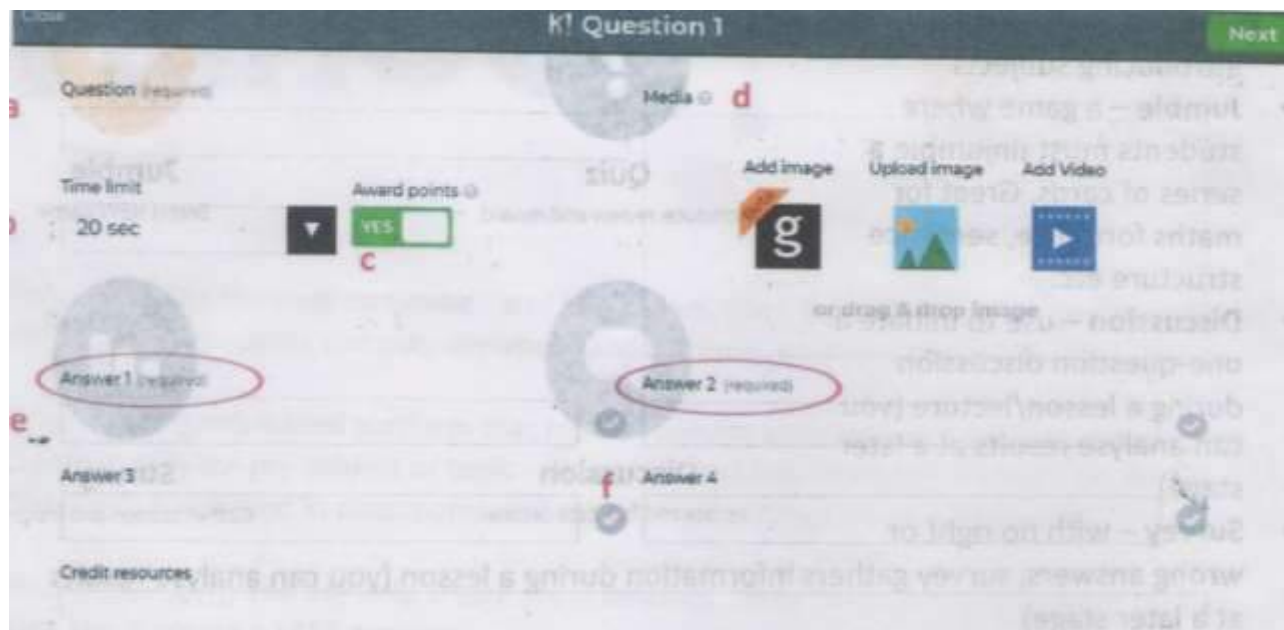
Create a Jumble

Choose **JUMBLE** and complete the **TITLE** screen, the same as you would for Quiz.

On the next page – the Jumble Creator, click **ADD JUMBLE QUESTION**.

Here we start creating the jumble questions:

The basic set up is the same as for QUIZ (refer to above)



However, Jumble is different to Quiz in that ALL the answers are correct but jumbled up and you must have **FOUR** answers. These are entered in the spaces **IN THE CORRECT ORDER**. During game play they will be jumbled or randomized.

Create A Survey

Choose **SURVEY** and complete the **TITLE** screen, the same as you would for Quiz.

On the next page – The Survey Creator, click **ADD QUESTION**.

Here we start creating the survey questions:

Complete as you would for QUIZ.

Note that there are NO POINTS awarded in Survey questions.

Create A Discussion

Choose **DISCUSSION** and complete the **TITLE** screen, the same as you would for Quiz.

On the next page – the Discussion Creator, click **ADD QUESTION**.

Here we enter the Discussion question – this is a **ONE** question activity only.

Complete as you would for QUIZ.

Note that there are NO POINTS awarded in Discussion questions.

How Do I Play A Kahoot?

Click on **MY KAHOOT**S from the toolbar to access your own Kahoots, or search for one that has already been pre-made

1. Choose the Kahoot to play and click the large PLAY button.
The number on this button shows how many times the Kahoot has been played [by you or other users]



2. Choose which Game Mode you want:
 - **Classic** [every player has their own device] or
 - **Team Mode** [1 device per team] – Team Mode is disabled [for now] with Jumble games

You can adjust the game settings/options before clicking

3. Tell your students to log in to the app, or on their PC at **kahoot.it**
 - They enter the GAME PIN [automatically generated and displayed on screen]
 - Enter their Names or Team Name and player Names
4. Click **START** on the Game page

How Do I Edit A Kahoot?

Click on **MY KAHOOT**S from the toolbar to access your own Kahoots. You can only edit your own Kahoots.

Locate the Kahoot you want to edit and mouse-over it, this will bring up the **Edit/Duplicate/Delete** links

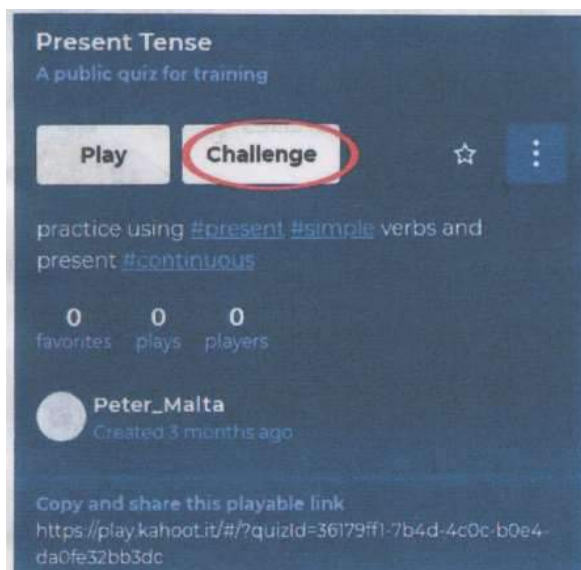


Challenges

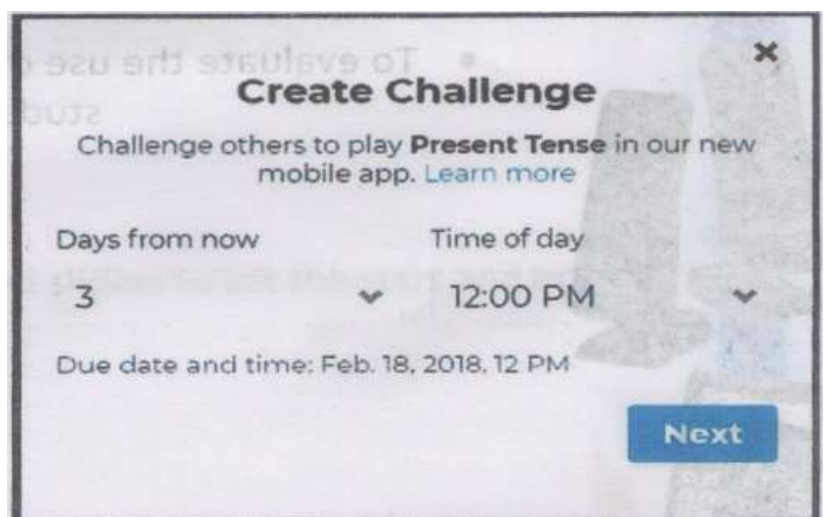
With the new Challenge option, you can assign a **Kahoot** as homework. Your students can play it at home on the mobile app.



1. Click on **MY KAHOOTs** from the toolbar to access your own Kahoots.
2. Locate the Kahoot to assign as a home work challenge and click on the **Title**
3. On the left side of the page that opens is a box that contains stats and links. Click on **CHALLENGE**

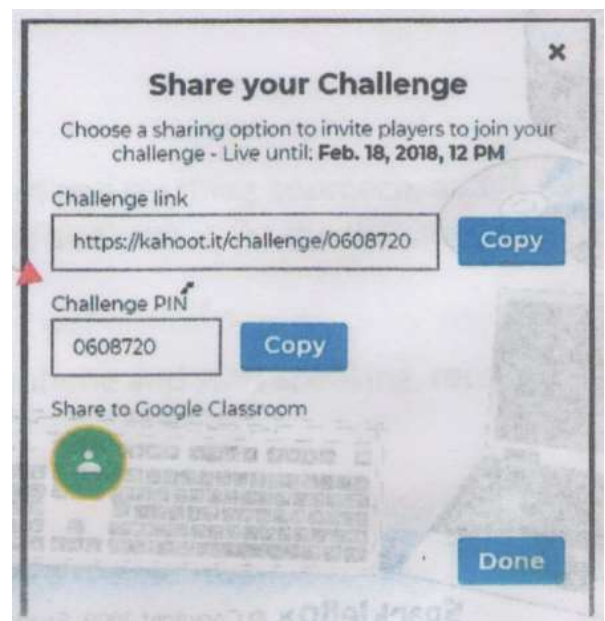


This will then open a settings box for the assignment. Change the date settings as per your requirements and click **NEXT**



4. Give your students the **CHALLENGE LINK** [for PC], and **GAME PIN CODE** [for mobile app].

This assignment can be posted to Google Classroom, or you can copy/paste the links in an email to your students or on your class web-page/social media group etc.

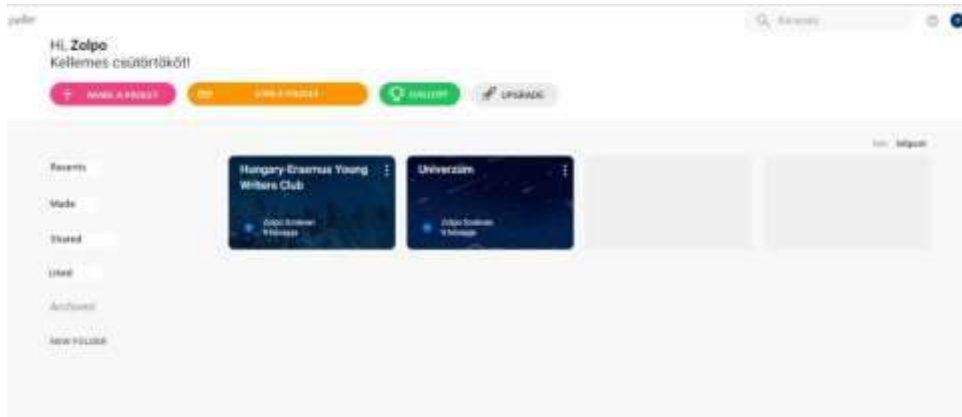

First you have to go to the website padlet.com. You can log in either with your google account or your facebook account. When you are ready doing this, you will see this surface.



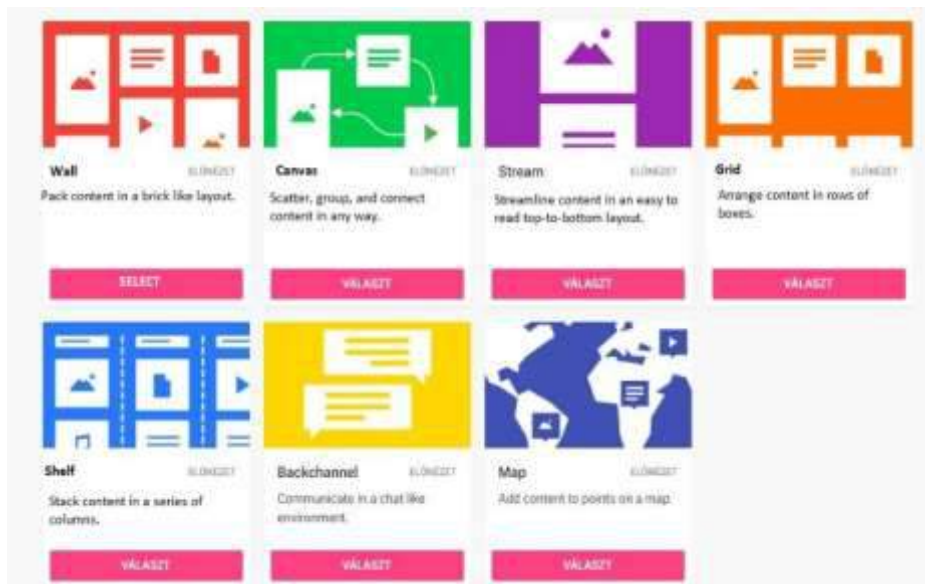
MAKING A PADLET

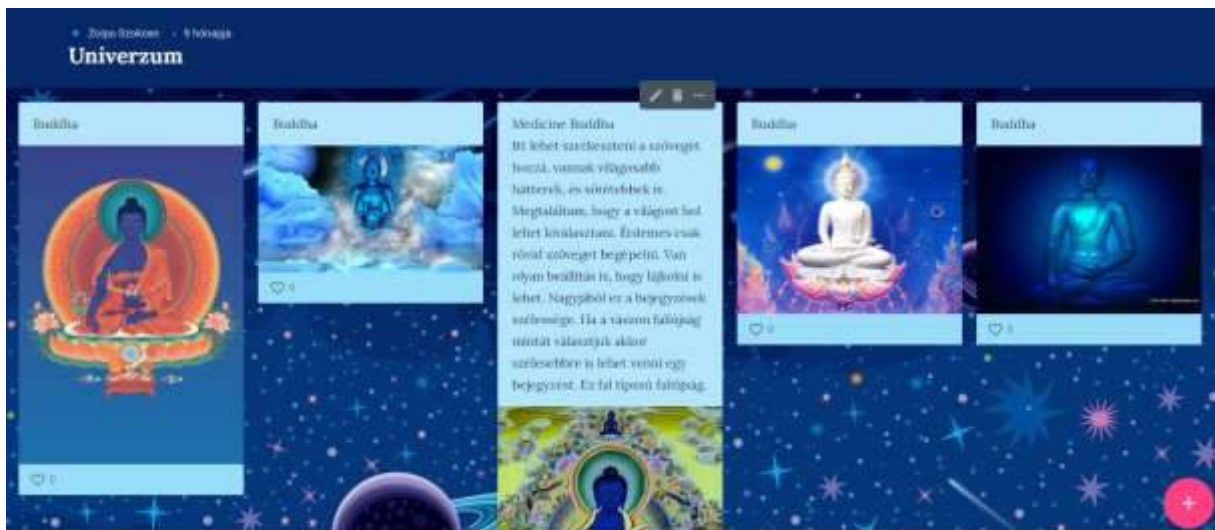

ThingLink

What is ThingLink?

ThingLink is a free and user friendly digital tool that provides users with the ability to turn any image into an interactive graphic. Create multiple “hot spots” on specific parts of an image and turn that image into a multimedia launcher. Include video, record audio or provide a link to any website with the click of a button. Easily embed an interactive ThingLink graphic into any blog or website. ThingLink is a truly amazing tool that allows users to pack a lot of content into a small space.

Ways to Use ThingLink for Teaching and Learning

Once you experiment with ThingLink I’m sure you will come up with many ways to use it for teaching and learning. Here are some ideas and interactive examples to get you started.

1. Use ThingLink as a Multimedia Curriculum Launcher

ThingLink provides teachers with opportunities to design multimedia rich student driven learning experiences that offer flexible learning paths to meet the diverse learning needs of all students. 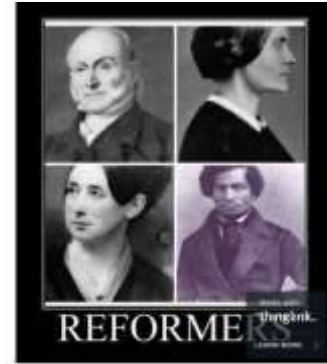

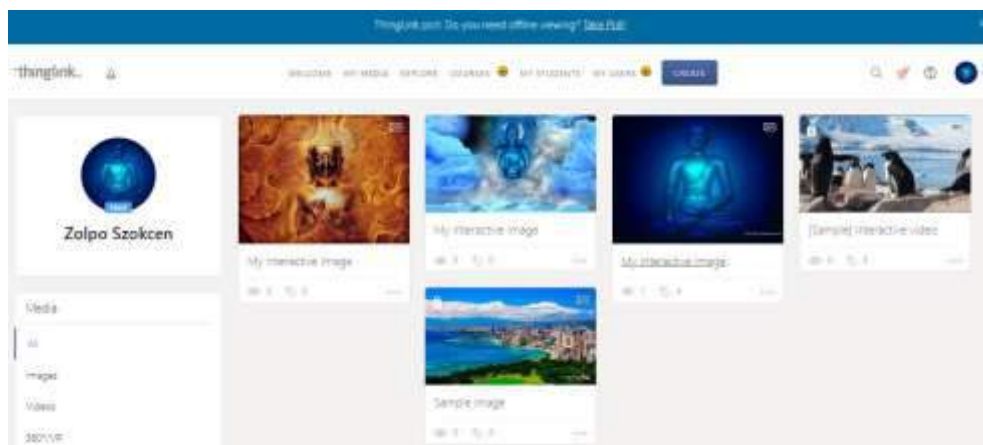

In the settings you can change your colour scheme, tag animation, hide or show ThingLink logo, and upload audio.

When you are ready with a tag, click on **SAVE AND CLOSE**.

You can always modify a tag or delete it if you want to. You can also move your tags in the picture, wherever you want to. This is a very useful webtool when you have a picture with lots of interesting things in it, and you want to speak about them. You can use your tags in any kinds of order. Searching for information doesn't require lots of time.



When you are ready with the tags you need, just click on the tag icon to open your tag.

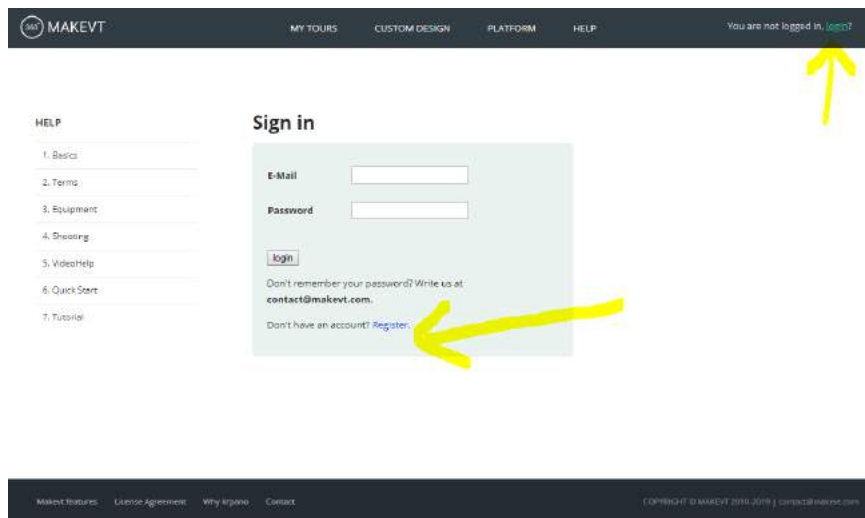

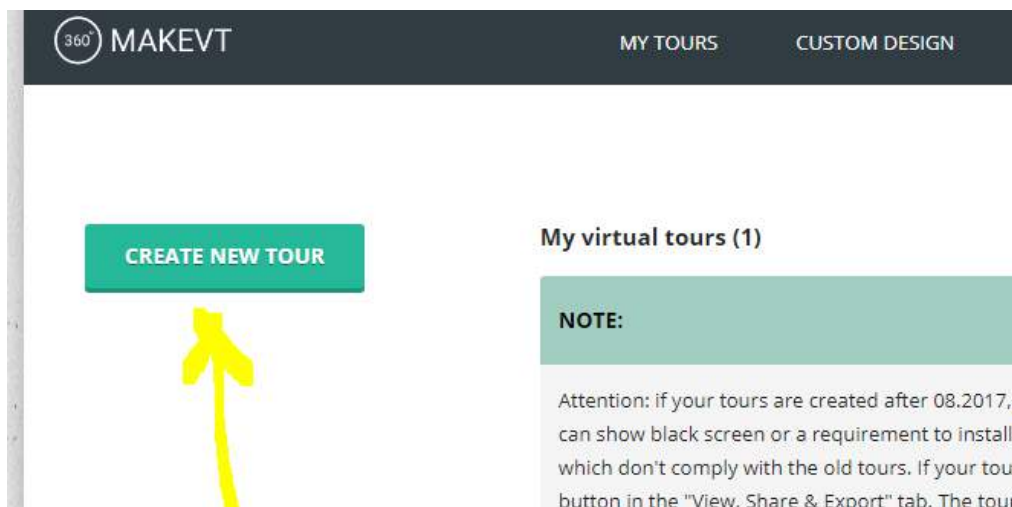

Before making your first virtual tour you need to [create your personal account](#). Your account will be created immediately. Please, use your real e-mail to avoid missing notifications about your tours.

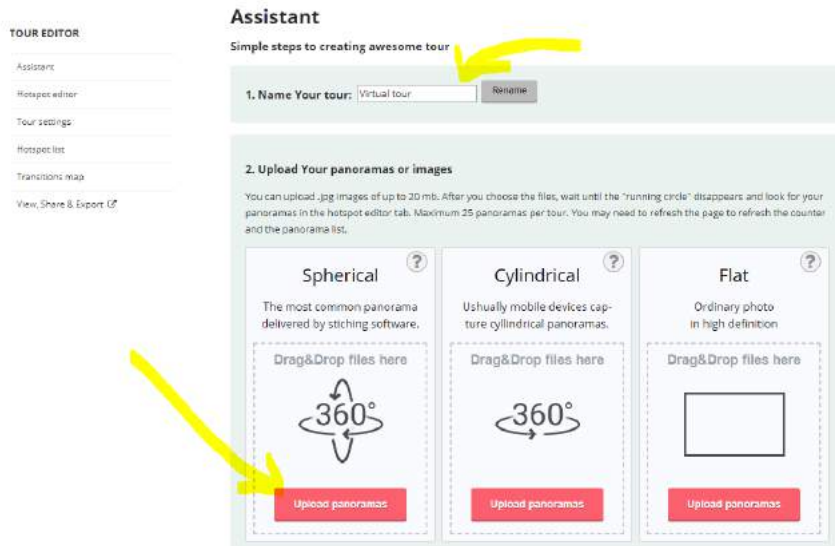


Creation of a virtual tour

1. Please, [login](#).
2. Create a new tour by clicking "Create a new tour". You will enter the editor;

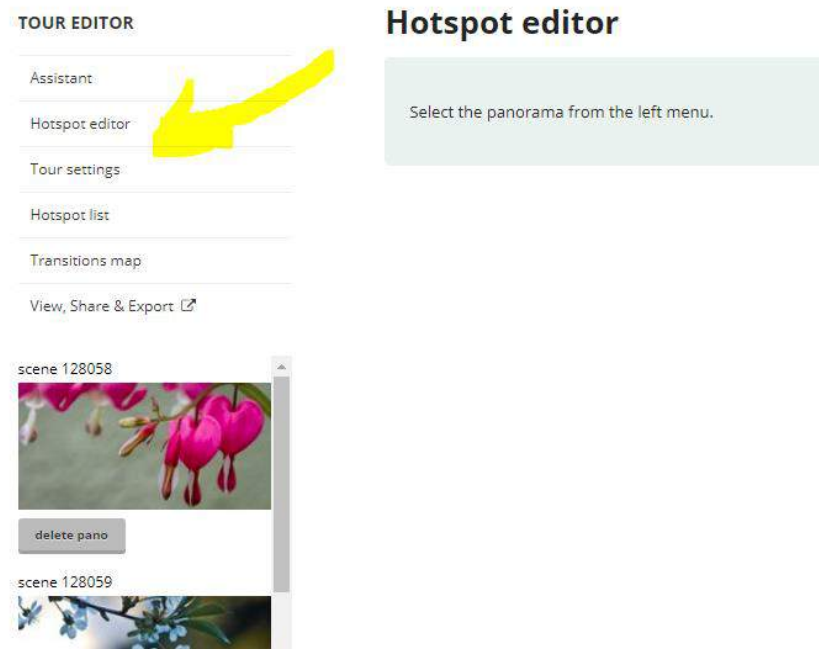


3. Upload your [panoramic .jpg files](#). To do this click on "Upload panoramas" in the Assistant tab;



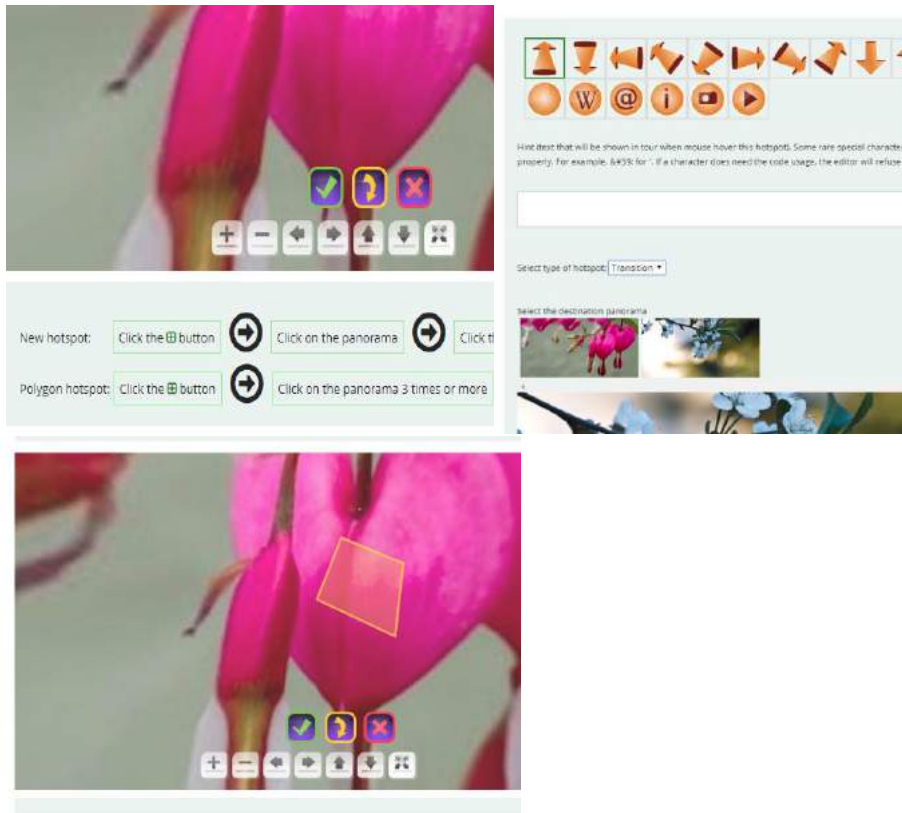
*Note - you have to wait a bit until the panoramas will be uploaded.
 Note - in current version only *.jpg format is supported*

4. Add hotspots. To do this you should click "Go to the hotspot editor" in the Assistant tab (or "Hotspot editor" in the left menu) and select a panorama in the left menu with thumbnails. This panorama will open in the hotspot editor;



Note - you have to wait until the selected panorama is preprocessed to be available in the hotspot editor. If it takes too long - refresh your page (F5 on your keyboard)

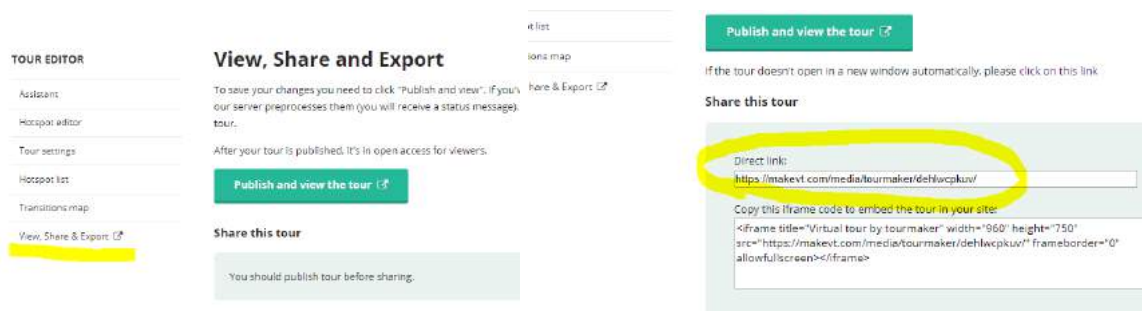
5. In the hotspot editor you can create [polygonal](#) and [point](#) hotspots ;



6. Create required hotspots by repeating steps 4 and 5 with other panoramas. You may check the hotspots by using the "Hotspot list" or the "Transition map" in the left menu;

Note - don't forget to click "redraw" in the "Transition map" tab every time you open it to see the latest changes

7. Set the name of the tour and the panorama, which should be seen first. To set the initial direction of the view you should set the "eye" (it corresponds with the center of the view) to a point on the first panorama;
8. To see your tour click "Publish your tour" in the Assistant tab and then "Publish and view";



9. Share the tour.

GETTING STARTED

Prezi is a highly innovative new way to present information to students, colleagues, and friends. Prezi allows you to combine pictures, graphics, charts, music, videos, and words to present an idea, lesson, or story. Creating your own prezi is easy and anyone can do it by simply going on to prezi.com and signing up for an account.

SIGNING UP FOR A PREZI ACCOUNT

1. Click on a web browser and go to www.prezi.com
2. Once on the website, select the **Get Started** button. (Located in the top right)
3. Once you have selected **Get Started** your screen should now say choose your prezi liscence. The details about each of the liscences is listed below. (Figure 1) If you plan to use prezi only a few times, the public free account would be the best option. However, if you plan to use create many different prezi presentation and use more in depth features, you may want to sign up for a more advanced version. For now click on the upper left tab, that says **Basic** and select the free verison. (Figure 2)

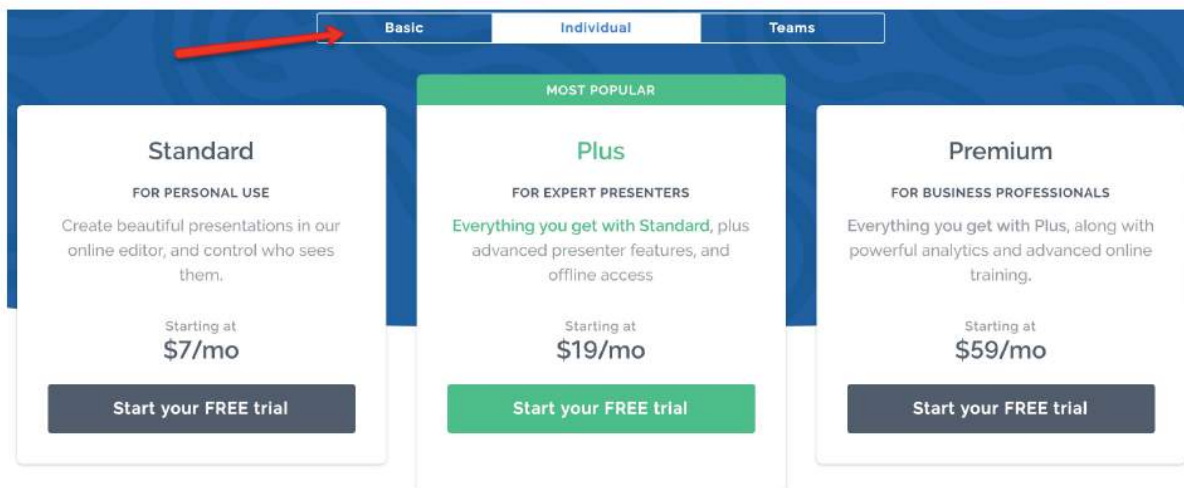

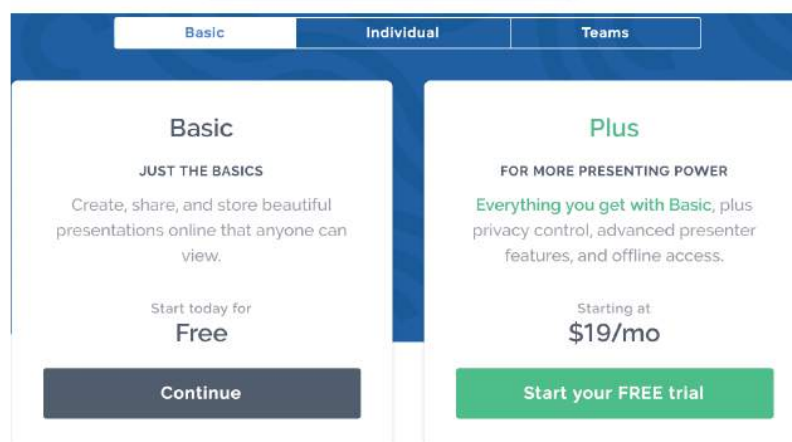

Creating a Prezi

1. You have now signed up for your very first prezi account. Congratulations! The next step is to create your new prezi. You can do this by clicking the box on the left hand side of the screen that says New Prentation. (Figure 4)

2. Once you select this it will take you to the templates page. Prezi offers a variety of different templates to choose from. Choose the one that will work best for your presentation. Once you have decided, select the template that you want and hit the choose button. (Figure 5)

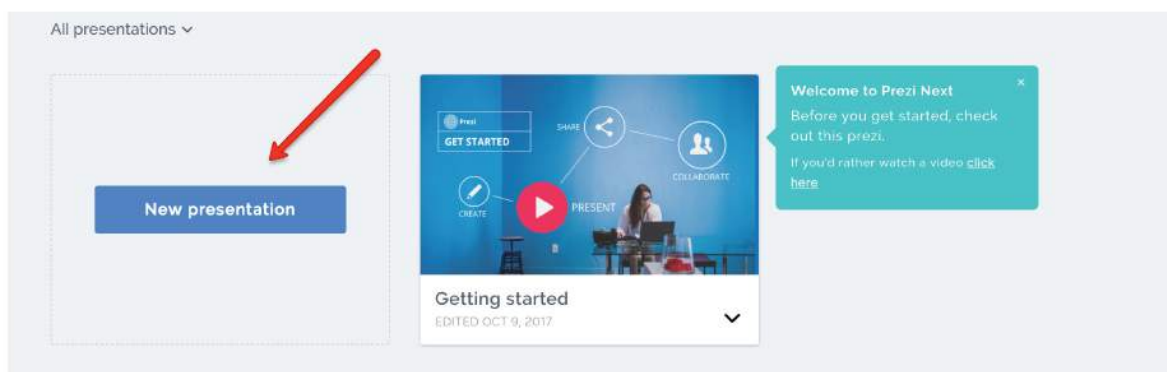

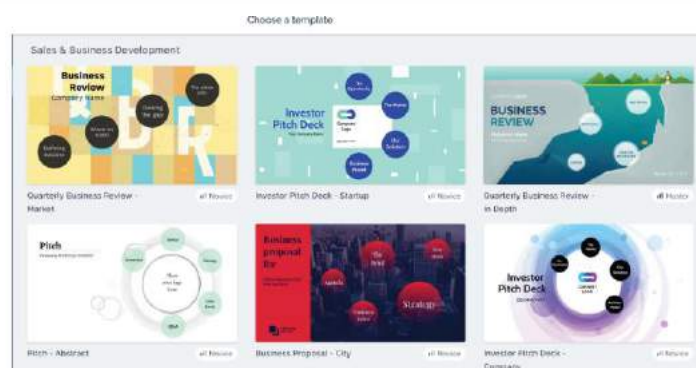

USING THE THEME TOOLS

1. Using the theme tools in Prezi allows you to give your presentation a particular theme and color design that works best for your presentation. To give your presentation a theme, start by going to the top of the page and selecting **Background & Theme**. (Figure 6)

2. Once you select **Background & Theme**, you should see a menu bar appear on the right hand side of the screen. From there you can insert your own background image and also choose theme colors. (Figure 7)

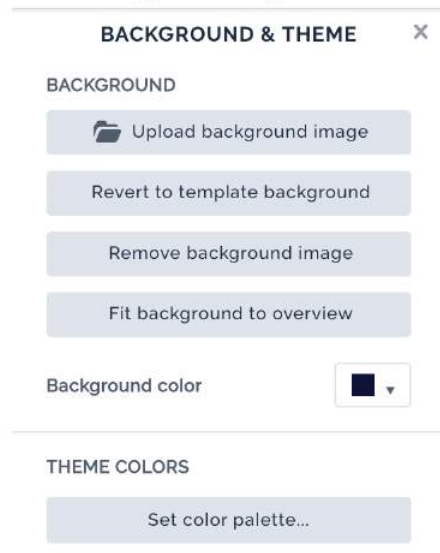

Adding Images on your Prezi

1. Prezi gives you the option of adding different pictures onto your presentation. To add an image onto your Prezi, go to the menu at the top of the screen and select the Insert Button. (Figure 8)

2. After selecting insert, select the Image option.

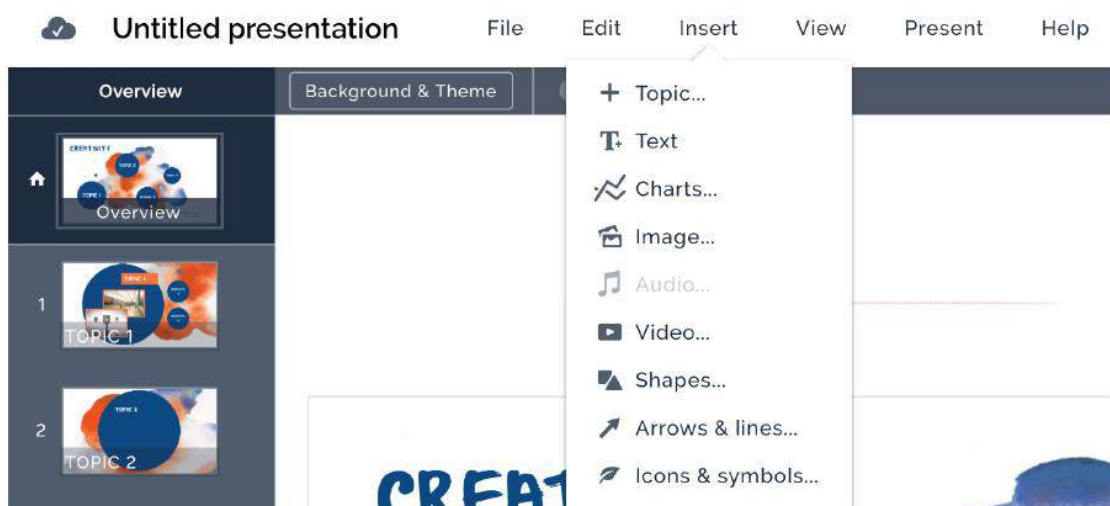

7. Once you have chosen your image, you can adjust the size and placement of the photo by simply clicking on the photo and adjusting the size with the blue box that will appear around the image. Move the image and adjust it to where you would like it to be placed on your prezi.

8. You can crop or delete the image by clicking on the image. a box will appear above saying crop or delete. Select the one you wish to use.

Adding Text to your Prezi

1. Adding text to prezi is very simple. Simply double click on the spot where you want the text to be added and a text box should appear.

2. Once you double click words above the box should appear. You can choose whether you want your text to be title size, subtitle size, or body size. Title is the biggest, body the smallest. Also if you want to adjust the size of your text you can use the big A or little A button. The big A will increase the text size and the little A will decrease the text size.

3. The box button next to the size buttons allows you to change the color of your text. Click the box and select the color you prefer.

4. If you click the > symbol to the right of the color box, this will bring up more options for you to use.

5. This will give you the option of creating bullet points for your text or will allow you to center your text to the right, left, or center.

6. Once you have added your text, click on another space on your prezi to click out of it. You can then adjust and move your text to whatever location you would like by simply clicking back on the text and moving it.

Adding A New Frame

1. Adding a new Frame to your prezi allows you to add different slides to your presentation. This will allow you to give your presentation or story an order for the viewers to follow.

2. To add a new frame, go to the **Overview** tab and at the bottom there is a button that says; **+ Topic**. This button allows you to add in new "Slides" (Figure 10)

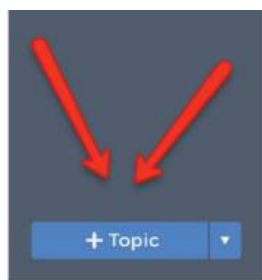

Inserting a Youtube Video

1. To insert a youtube video on your prezzi presentation, go to the insert button on the top menu and select. (Figure 11)
2. Select **Video...** A tab should open up on the right hand side, that allows you to insert your YouTube video.
3. Go to YouTube. Once you have found the video, copy the web address link for your video.
4. Go back to prezzi and paste this link in the “post youtube link” box. and select the insert button. Move the video to the location you want by clicking on it and dragging it to the right location.

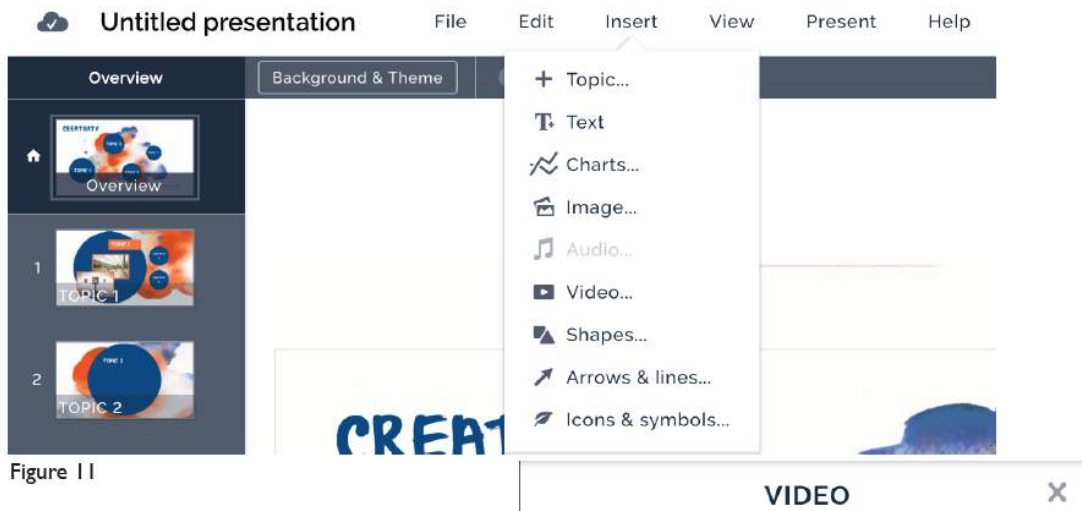

 2. Along the top next to **Background & Theme** there is a music note, click on it and it will open a bar on the right hand side.

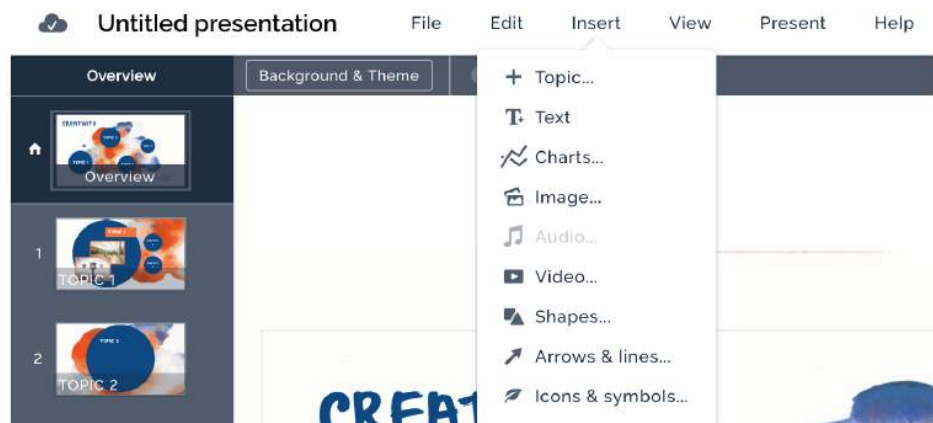

4. To exit your presentation, hit the escape key one the upper left hand corner of your keyboard. Congratulations on your presentation!

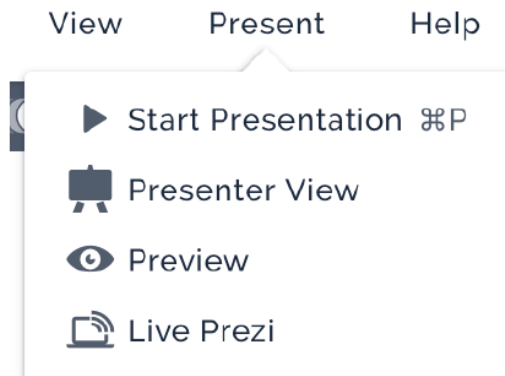
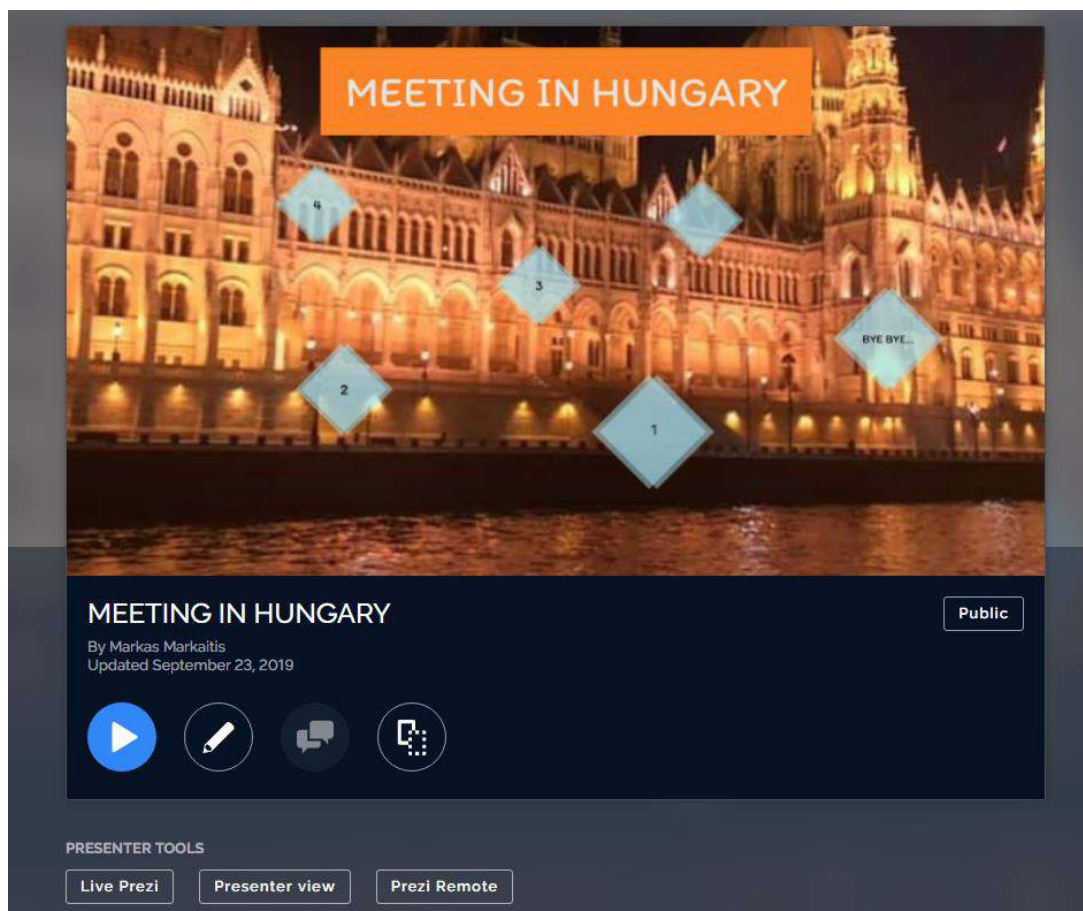

At this point it is necessary to choose a style from those available. By clicking on one of them, you can preview it. Once the style has been selected, you can proceed by clicking on create video.



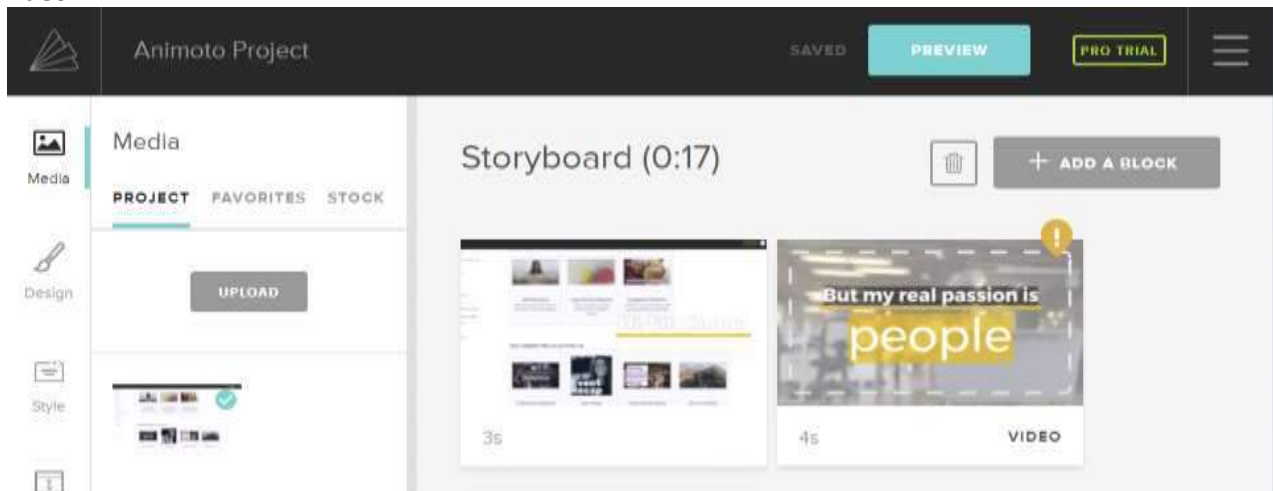
